# Blueprints

## ISTEP+: Grade 5 Social Studies Blueprint Beginning Spring 2015

*There are four Indiana Standards for Grade 5 Social Studies, and they are divided into four categories for reporting student achievement. Age-appropriate concepts are assessed within each category.*

Reporting Category	Standards Assessed and Description	Percent Range *
1 – History	<p><b>Standard 1</b></p> <p>Questions may include comparing Indian groups from various North American regions; explaining why early Europeans explored North America and the results of those explorations; identifying and describing characteristics of early cultures and Spanish, French, and British settlements in North America; identifying instances of both cooperation and conflict between Native American Indiana and European settlers; explaining the causes of the American Revolution; and interpreting timelines and graphic aids in historical context.</p>	32-42%
2 – Civics and Government	<p><b>Standard 2</b></p> <p>Questions may include explaining the importance of the Declaration of Independence; providing examples of individual rights from the Bill of Rights; describing civic responsibility; and describing the three branches of government.</p>	16-26%
3 – Geography	<p><b>Standard 3</b></p> <p>Questions may include identifying regions within the U.S.; identifying important political and physical features in the U.S.; locating the Continental Divide and major drainage basins in the U.S.; using latitude and longitude to find places on a map; finding distances between places on a map; explaining how land affected historical events; and describing how Native American Indian and colonists adapted to their environment.</p>	20-30%
4 – Economics	<p><b>Standard 4</b></p> <p>Questions may include describing economic activities among Native American cultures; understanding a market economy; predicting the effect of changes in supply and demand; and explaining how the economy has affected history.</p>	13-23%

\* This range represents the approximate emphasis for each reporting category on the assessment.
