## Important information regarding ACCUPLACER for 2016-17....

*The following details are designed to assist you in preparing for the administration of ACCUPLACER, **Part 1 and Part 2 test windows.***

### ❖ Testing Windows

- The 2016-17 ACCUPLACER testing windows are:
  - Part 1: October 3, 2016 – November 23, 2016
  - Part 2: February 13, 2017 – March 31, 2017

### ❖ Testing Windows and Participation Criteria

The statewide testing window is **October 3, 2016 – March 31, 2017**. The test window is divided into two parts:

- **Part 1: October 3, 2016 – November 23, 2016**

Part 1 testers should include:

- **Juniors** who meet participation criteria outlined in the Part 1 Participation Criteria flowchart.

- **Part 2: February 13, 2017 – March 31, 2017**

Part 2 testers should include:

- **Juniors** determined to need remediation as a result of the CCR exam taken during Part 1 who wish to enroll in a dual credit course in ELA or Math as a senior.
- **Seniors** who participated in ACCUPLACER as a grade 11 student in the 2015-16 administration.
- **Seniors** on track to receive a general diploma with an evidence-based waiver who want to qualify for state financial aid for stand-alone remedial courses.

**Schools should plan to administer the assessment to students who meet the participation criteria during **Part 1 and Part 2.****

- In preparation for the ACCUPLACER **Part 1 & 2** test administration, the attached graphics have been designed to assist schools in determining **student participation.**
