SUBJECT: Estimate of Reimbursement for 2016 Summer School Programs

A total of 303 school corporations and charter schools reported expenditure estimates for the 2016 summer school programs. The total estimated costs submitted totaled more than \$29 million.

Attached is a list of the qualifying school corporations and charter schools that are eligible for reimbursement and the estimated amounts for distribution. Only those schools on the attached list are eligible to seek reimbursement for actual costs submitted later this year. The percentage of reimbursement will be adjusted in the Fall based on final costs submitted by eligible school corporations.

In order to receive reimbursement for summer school costs, the Final Costs Report must be submitted on or before Thursday, September 15, 2016. The window to begin submitting the Final Costs Report will open on Friday, July 29, 2016.

Summer school curricula can prove important to the success of many of our students. Schools may want to explore opportunities to minimize local costs by offering courses with other school corporations or holding courses at central locations such as area vocational schools. Corporations that jointly offer programs can more easily share expenses.
