SUBJECT: Estimate of Reimbursement for 2015 Summer School Programs

A total of 289 school corporations and charter schools reported expenditure estimates for the 2015 summer school programs that totaled more than \$29 million.

Based on the expenditure estimates submitted, Category 1 could receive funding at 73%. There will be no reimbursement for Category 2. Category 1 classes include Grades 1-3 reading and Grades 9-12 courses towards graduation, including electives. Attached is a list of the qualifying school corporations/charter schools estimated amounts to be received. Only those schools on the attached list are seeking reimbursement for actual costs submitted later this year.

The final reimbursement amounts will be determined when actual expenditure data is received this fall. Please refer to the 2015 Summer School Program Eligible Courses listed at <http://www.doe.in.gov/idoie/grants-management/summer-school>

Summer school curricula can prove important to the success of many of our students. Schools may want to explore opportunities to minimize local costs by offering courses with other school corporations or holding courses at central locations such as area vocational schools. Corporations that jointly offer programs can more easily share expenses.
