

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ON-LINE TRAINING FOR SCHOOL NURSES REGARDING THE CARE OF STUDENTS WITH DIABETES

The Indiana Department of Education, in conjunction with diabetes experts, has developed an on-line training course for school nurses. The course contains 9 different modules. These modules consist of the following topics:

1. Indiana Code 20-34-5: Understanding the Law and IHP's
2. Nutrition in the School Setting
3. Helping Your Students Make Better Food Choices
4. Meters and Pen Overview
5. Pumps in the School Setting
6. Managing Hyperglycemia and Hypoglycemia
7. Scenarios in the School Setting
8. Care of Student with Diabetes – Three Quizzes
9. Additional Resources

You are welcome to view all of the modules. Some of the modules are listed as mandatory as the material in the module is covered on the post-quizzes, and some are listed as optional. The information presented in the optional modules is not covered on the post-quizzes, but is additional information that may be helpful to you.

At the end of this course, there are three quizzes for you to take. Each quiz counts towards your final grade. The quizzes are 10 questions each and are divided into three topics. These topics include: The Diabetic Law and IHP's, Out of Range and Emergency Care, and Daily Management and Care. In order to successfully complete, receive credit and a certificate for this course, you must achieve 100% mastery on all quizzes. You may take each quiz as many times as you wish to earn a grade of 100%. Each time you log in to take a quiz, random questions, in random order, are generated.

You do not need to go through all of the modules in order to take the quizzes. If you have had training regarding the care of students with diabetes in the past, you may skip to Module 8 and take each of the quizzes to test your knowledge. You will receive credit and a certificate if you pass all three quizzes with 100%. If you do not achieve 100% or would like more information regarding any of the topics, you may view any or all of the modules listed for this course. This website will be checked and certificates will be e-mailed to those achieving 100% on all three quizzes at the beginning of each month.

In Summary:

- The purpose of the quizzes is to test your knowledge regarding the care of students with diabetes.
- If you have taken training in the past, and you feel that you are knowledgeable regarding the care of students with diabetes – log on to the moodle website and take the quizzes. There is no need to view the other modules, you may just skip to module 8 and take the quizzes.
- The modules are for your use in order to receive training if you have never attended one or to review any material you feel would be helpful to you.
