grade levels. I have consulted with not only teachers in my school and grade level, but also with other teachers from other schools and varying grade levels including junior/senior high teachers. I have also consulted with special areas, writing, special education teachers and our school counselor. They have provided me with advice on teaching strategies and classroom organization and management. They have also shared teaching materials, but most importantly they have offered support and reassurance.

There are 14 other school psychologists that I work closely with in the special education department. There are also weekly meetings within the department with the special education manager.

Many people in the South Vermillion school district was willing to help whenever I needed it. I worked closely with the Covered Bridge Special Education department, and attended many formal meetings about the IEP

At Deming, the teachers work very closely together. Also, I am completing my Master's degree through Indiana State University, which provided additional knowledge and support during my first two years teaching.

Almost every day, I would meet with the other upper hall teachers and talk about techniques, tips and tricks, and ask any questions I may have. Also, I worked closely with the principal to make sure everything in my classroom was flowing well and to make sure I was able to ask any questions and have them answered quickly.

While working closely with L.J., a teacher of 20+ years, I was also paired with Jessica Whitkanack. She is considered my "coach", who guides me as needed with lesson plans, classroom management, and any other. Being employed the past two years as a Curriculum Director, I have worked closely with three experienced building-level principals, who provided guidance and served as informal mentors. I also had monthly meetings. The principals, counselors, and more experienced teachers were all instrumental in helping me as an educator. I didn't just have one or two mentors, I had several.
