We met a few days out of the week to work together. 3. I taught an English class that consisted of freshmen and sophomores. All the students had an IEP. I co-taught with the high school special education teacher, Mrs. A. C. We would work closely to create and differentiate the curriculum to the students needs.

Experienced teacher on-site trained and mentored me, while my college course professors also offered mentoring. I took Special Education courses through Oakland City University, with my current instructor, Ted Pearson. Also, at MJCF, the teacher who helped me was/is S. G.

Assigned a full time teacher with 18 years as my peer mentor. She and I discuss everything from lesson plans to behavior management. We speak informally daily and meet formally as outlined in our mentoring handbook. The principal was always available for questions, and the executive secretary also had years of experience to help me with anything I had questions over. My fellow teachers also were very supportive.

I was paired with a teacher in my school that taught close to the same thing I am teaching. She observed me teaching, answered questions, and help guide me in anything I needed.
