

INNOVATIONS IN DIESEL POWER

The Southeastern Career Center's (SCC) Diesel program is partnering with Cummins by teaching state-of-the-art diesel technology curriculum. Utilizing joint donations from Cummins Engine and Crum Trucking, SCC students are getting experience with new models of diesel trucks and 53 new high-end engines.

In conjunction with new engines, is the "INSITE Computer Diesel Engine". This tool allows students the ability to see and hear a diesel engine running at its best as well as show the faults an engine can encounter. As each fault is shown, the students can see and hear differences in engine sounds.

Cummins also makes available to SCC students a service known as "Cummins Virtual College". Cummins Virtual College allows students to take classes online to receive advanced training that can be utilized while working with Cummins or a job that services Cummins engines.

In the fall of 2014, SCC will be expanding the Automotive-Diesel programs to include two Automotive Dynamometer System labs. Both of these labs will bring the students in contact with applications they would not normally experience until working in the field. With these new additions to the Southeastern Career Center's programs, students will have access to state-of-the-art total turnkey processes of any automotive application they would experience in the professional world of diesel engine maintenance.
