

HOUSE BILL 1374 PERMITTING THREE (3) SCHOOL AGE
CHILDREN OVER LICENSED CAPACITY

- PURPOSE:** To establish procedures to allow family day care providers to claim and care for three (3) school age children over their licensed capacity.
- SCOPE:** Sponsors and providers participation in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP).
- DESCRIPTION:** All children **must** be enrolled in the family day care home and included on the monthly enrollment roster.
- The additional school age children must be in first grade or above in order to qualify. Providers will be required to indicate the school age child's age **and grade level** on the mandatory enrollment roster.
- House Bill 1374 states that this provision is not in effect when school is out of session for one (1) month or longer. This policy will not be in effect during summer vacation time, except for students attending summer school, and then for only the time the summer school classes are in session.
- School age children must be served 6-12 year old serving sizes and their meals must be documented at the point of service in order for the meals to qualify for CACFP reimbursement.
