WE ARE Mooreville Schools located in Mooreville, Indiana. Mooreville Schools is a small suburban school district in Morgan County. We work with over 4,500 students, and employ over 300. Our school corporation is home to: Mooreville High School, Paul Hadley Middle School, Neil Armstrong Elementary School, Newby Elementary School, North Madison Elementary School, Northwood Elementary School, and Waverly Elementary School.

OUR STUDENTS & FAMILIES are supportive and proud of the safety efforts and precautions that are in place for all Mooreville Schools. Working with community and state emergency personnel, we have been able to put safety measures in place for crises that may occur.

OUR PROMISING PRACTICE is conducting safety drills throughout the school year, but most importantly is our Code Red Full-Scale Drill. This drill is completed using a variety of community and state agencies that come together to practice their individualized disciplines. This drill also allows us to audit our own safety practices and make changes where they are necessary.

OUR STEPS include each school having specific safety plans put in place for man-made and natural disasters. Our Code Red Full-Scale Drill is conducted using a variety of scenarios, such as: intruder; hostage situation; explosives; and missing person. These drills are conducted on site, at the school, and involve over fifteen state and local agencies. Each agency is able to practice their discipline with a round-table collaboration amongst the agencies. A debriefing meeting is held with all agencies involved by the School Safety Specialist. We work together to make improvement and corrections for subsequent drills which also allows our schools to analyze their safety plans to ensure students are safe and secure in their buildings.

IN OUR OWN WORDS "A Code Red Full-Scale Drill allows all stakeholders in our county to practice their skills in the event a disaster would happen in our schools. The drill also allows us to collaborate to understand what each agency's responsibilities would be to support our students and staff in the event we would have a lock-down scenario at Mooreville Schools."
