Susan obtained her Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of South Carolina and a Master's Degree of Science in Counseling and Human Development from Troy State University in Montgomery. She is a Fellow with the American Institute of Stress and is a Board Certified Expert in Traumatic Stress through the American Academies of Experts in Traumatic Stress. She is also the President/Founder of Under The Shield, Inc., a non profit business providing free counseling and other support services to emergency services personnel and their families.

Important Information

This training is *free* to all state, county, and local law enforcement agencies. **Two nights** lodging (9/7 & 9/8) will be paid for Indiana state, county, or local law enforcement only (employees of the federal government or private corporations are not eligible). For lodging to be covered, the eligible attendees must live more than 50 miles from the conference location. Attendees staying more than the designated 2 night's are responsible for the extra night's expense. Those who register and *do not* attend will be responsible for the lodging expense if not cancelled by the required deadlines. Mileage and per diem will not be covered and are the responsibility of the individual or agency. **All hotel rooms will be double occupancy with ONLY conference attendees.**

Lodging will be at the Indianapolis Marriott East, 7202 East 21st Street, Indianapolis, IN 46219. **Lodging requests must be received by August 19, 2016 (The US Attorney's Office will make the reservations, cancellations and/or room assignments for preferred partners).
