## **"School And Community Response To Active Shooter"**

### **Training Description:**

This training is designed to provide an update on active shooter response for schools and their partners in law enforcement, fire, and emergency services. The morning session will include presentations by law enforcement related to responses protocols in the event of school violence. The session will focus on active shooter events, law enforcement response, and how this response can impact school safety plans. The afternoon session will include a full-scale exercise involving local law enforcement, fire services, and emergency medical services. The exercise will follow a "live" event with entry to a school, suppression of the shooter, clearing of the scene, medical assistance and crisis management.
