Indicator 12

Percent of children referred by Part C prior to age 3, who are found eligible for Part B, and who have an individualized education program (IEP) developed and implemented by their third birthdays.

Measurement:

- a. # of children who have been served in Part C and referred to Part B for eligibility determination.
- b. # of those referred determined to be NOT eligible and whose eligibilities were determined prior to their third birthdays.
- c. # of those found eligible who have an IEP developed and implemented by their third birthdays.
- d. # of children for whom parent refusal to provide consent caused delays in evaluation or initial services.
- e. # of children who were referred to Part C less than 90 days before their third birthdays.

Account for children included in "a" but not included in "b", "c" or "d". Indicate the range of days beyond the third birthday when eligibility was determined and the IEP developed and the reasons for the delays.

$$\text{Percent} = [(c) \div \text{by } (a - b - d)] \times 100.$$
