To set the *Difficulty Level*, go to **Scheduling | Master Schedule | Search and View** section. The codes (please see code section after data layout) are entered under **Scheduling | Set up | Difficulty level**. If the difficulty level is left blank, the program will export the course as a “Regular” course. It is only necessary to update those which do not fit into this category.

To set up *Standardized Tests*, go to **System Preferences | Set up | Standardized Test**.

- **\*Name:** Enter the name of the test as seen in the list in the section “Standardized Test (Education Test Codes)” on page 15.
- **\*Display Text:** The display text will print on the transcript and the transcript-landscape reports. This is the information which will display in the *Note Message* field of the file layout below for each test.
- **\*Code:** Enter a unique identifier for this test.
- **Description:** Enter the description as seen in the list in the section “Standardized Test (Education Test Codes)” on page 15.

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NOTE: For the ECA and ISTEP tests, which should be reported on the transcripts, enter *OtherStateTest* in the description field of the standardized test setup. If there are other tests which need to report on the transcript but are not listed above, enter *OtherTest* in the description. The information entered in the *Display Text* will be listed in the *Note Message* field in the export layout.

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- **Display on Transcript:** Check if this test is to be displayed on student transcripts. Users also have the ability to select this option on the individual student records. Only those standardized tests marked to *Display on transcript* will be included in the CET export to Parchment.

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WARNING! If the user checks or unchecks the *Display On Transcript* option and clicks **OK**, this will overwrite any options that have been set on the individual student’s standardized test record.

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- **Test Components:** Enter the various sections of the test for which a student may receive a score. Please see the list of test components under “Standardized Test Component—Subtest” on page 19. *Test Component Code* is to be entered into the *Code* field. *Test Component Name* is to be entered into the *Name* field. A *State*, *SIF* or *NCES/Other* code is not required for the CET export.



- To correct this error, do the following:
  - Go to the year in which the course was taken and check the *State Course Code* field under **Scheduling | Master Schedule | Section**.
  - If the state code is missing from the section, go to **Scheduling | Valid Courses**. Search for and open the course to view/edit the record.
  - If the state course code is already listed, it is necessary to get the data to push back out the sections. Using the **Apply Changes** feature will not work in this case.
  - Start by opening the Valid Course record and removing the State Course Code from its field and then click **OK** to save the record.
  - Go back into the Valid Course and reenter the State Course Code. Click **OK** to save the record. This will update the sections and remove the error from the report.
  - The final way in which to remove the error is to ensure the use of Indiana State Course Codes when keying in any transfer grades into a student's transcript. If the course is taught at your school, always select it from the Valid Course list. If the course is not taught at your school, do not make up your own code but refer to the State Course Code list found on the Department of Education's Web site.
  - \*See the section "Entering Transfer Grades" on page 10 for steps to enter transfer grades onto a student's transcript.

Once the errors have been corrected for each student, you may run the CET export with *Upload to Parchment* selected to transmit your students' transcripts.

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NOTE: If it necessary to send the Rank GPA calculation to Parchment rather than the cumulative GPA, there is now an option to **Send Student Rank instead of GPA**. This refers to the GPA which is calculated and posted to the most recent Transcript Term. In most cases, the cumulative GPA (found at the top of the student transcript screen) and the Rank GPA are the same value; however, this option has been added to accommodate schools districts which use the Advanced GPA calculations.

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\*\*Please verify with your Customer Care Representative if you have questions concerning the use of the Advanced GPA.



- **Difficulty Level:** Indicate the difficulty level of the course (i.e., *AP*). If the difficulty level is left blank, the course will export as *Regular* on the CET file.
- **Student Grade Details:** Enter the appropriate Alpha, Numeric, GPA Credits and Grad Credits.
- **Grade Points:** Enter the appropriate values into each *GPA Method Unweighted* or *Weighted* field in which the course is to be used to calculate a GPA.


Once the information for the course has been entered, click **OK** and the screen will reset to enter the next course. Repeat the steps above until all courses have been entered for the Term. Once the term window is complete, move on to the next term and enter the appropriate course and grade information.

After transfer grades have been entered, those grades will not be included in the Cumulative GPA, Rank GPA or used to determine the Class Rank for students until the **Post Grades to Transcripts** or **Reconcile Term GPA and Rank** processes have been run. You may choose to reconcile if grades have already been posted for the current year. If grades have not been posted yet, use the **Post Grades to Transcripts** process when it is appropriate to post.

- To post grades or to reconcile go to **Mgmt Console | Console**.



- Select **Post Grades to Transcript** if posting for the first time this school year. It is now possible to post grades only for a selected grade level(s).



- Select **Reconcile Term GPA and Rank** if grades have been posted and the Term GPA and Class Rank only need to be updated. It is now possible to reconcile for a selected grade level(s).
