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Thank you for your recent benchmark submission provided for renewal of your 1003(g) School Improvement Grant ("SIG. In our review of the submission, we found that Joyce Kilmer Elementary School #69 ("Joyce Kilmer") did not meet any academic indicators. The standard for renewal, as found both in the Indiana Department of Education ("IDOE") SIG 1003(g) Grant Renewal Criteria and the Benchmark Worksheet, required Joyce Kilmer to meet at least two academic indicators to qualify for renewal of the SIG grant.

In conducting our review, we relied on the academic goals provided and the academic results provided both by Joyce Kilmer ("Percent of students at or above proficient") and by the IDOE data team ("Average scale score"). The indicators are provided below.
