Choice Scholarship Program "F" Public School Track 2021-2022 School Year

Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the "F" Public School Track.

1. A student must:
 - a. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
 - b. Be between the ages of 5 and 22 by August 1;
- AND
2. A student must:
 - a. Be required to attend a specific public school based on their residence that has been assigned an "F" grade. (This track does not require prior attendance at the school.)
- AND
3. A student must be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 150% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)
