



**Choice Scholarship Program
 Previous Choice Track
 2020-2021 School Year**

Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the Previous Choice Track.

1. A student must:
 - a. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
 - b. Be between the ages of 5 and 22 by August 1st; AND

2. A student must:
 - a. Have received a Choice Scholarship in a school year that does not immediately precede the school year for which the student is applying for Choice Scholarship;

OR

 - b. Have received a Choice Scholarship in the immediately preceding school year, but the student exited the Choice Scholarship school prior to the end of the school year;

AND

3. A student must be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 150% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)
