

**Choice Scholarship Program
Previous SGO Pathway
2018-2019 School Year**

Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the Previous SGO Pathway.

1. A student must:
 - a. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
 - b. Be between the ages of 5 and 22 by August 1st; **AND**
 - c. Be accepted for enrollment into a participating Choice Scholarship school.
2. A student must:
 - a. Have received an SGO Scholarship in a **previous school year, including a school year that does not immediately precede** the school year for which the student is applying for a Choice Scholarship; **AND**
 - b. Have received the SGO Scholarship from one of the eight approved Scholarship Granting Organizations. (Community Foundation of Elkhart County, Institute for Quality Education, LaGrange County Community Foundation, Inc., School Scholarship Granting Organization of Northeast Indiana, Tuition Assistance Fund of Southwestern Indiana, Sagamore Institute for Education Choice, The Lutheran Scholarship Granting Organization of Indiana, and Professional Athletes of Indiana).

AND

3. A student must be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 150% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Reduced Lunch Program.

For a household size of eleven (11) or more, add \$7,992 to the annual limit for each additional member for a 90% scholarship and add \$11,988 to the annual limit for each additional member for a 50% scholarship.

90% and 50% Choice Scholarships are 90% and 50% of the public tuition support amount of a student's public school corporation of legal settlement. 90% and 50% award amounts can be found at www.doe.in.gov/choice under Estimated Award Amounts by Corporation.
