



**Choice Scholarship Program  
Sibling Track  
2020-2021 School Year**

**Student must satisfy all criteria to qualify for the Choice Scholarship Program under the Sibling Track.**

1. A student must:
  - a. Have legal settlement in Indiana;
  - b. Be between the ages of 5 and 22 by August 1st; AND
  
2. A student must:

Have a sibling who received either a Choice Scholarship or an SGO Scholarship of at least \$500 in a preceding school year, including a school year that does not immediately precede the school year for which the student is applying for a Choice Scholarship. (A minimum \$500 SGO Scholarship only applies to a sibling of the student who received an SGO Award for the first time after June 30, 2013);

AND

3. A student must be a member of a household with an annual income equal to or below 150% of the amount to qualify for the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program. (IC 20-51-1-4.3)
