284 districts



Teachers have the most favorable opinion of evaluation practices in their schools.


Favorable Responses to Teacher Topics
(National Percentile if available)




Insights

1. The distribution of district-level percent favorable responses varies by survey topic.

2. Most teachers plan to stay both in their district and in the teaching profession for 10+ more years.



3. For teachers who consider leaving their district or the teaching profession soon, pay and professional climate are the main factors.
