Reciprocal Permits

Under No Child Left Behind (NCLB) a teacher holding a Reciprocal Permit ***may not be counted as Highly Qualified until they have corrected the deficiencies that were issued by the state of Indiana, and they have been issued a valid standard Indiana Teaching License.***
