CLARIFY EXPECTATIONS FOR ...

TEACHERS

Keep this in mind:

Online learning helps students
practice learning independently.

However, **they are learning to learn online**
while learning new concepts.

Provide structure to help them succeed.

- Check in regularly & reach out frequently
- Provide useful and useable feedback
- Encourage replies to gradebook comments
- Invite students to ask questions.
- Establish clear schedules, routines, & deadlines
- Remember that this is hard for students, too.

STUDENTS & FAMILIES

Keep this in mind:

Just because students may know how to
play informally online
does not mean they know how to
learn formally online.

- Check in regularly & reach out frequently
- Read feedback & apply it to new assignments
- Respond to gradebook comments
- Ask specific questions early & often.
- Follow schedules & routines; meet deadlines
- Remember that this is hard for teachers, too.

EXPECTATIONS FOR EVERYONE

Learning online feels & looks different than learning face to face.
That's ok.

Keep an open mind & establish a dialogue between teachers, students, and families.
Adjust expectations as time passes and circumstances change.

Be understanding of yourself and others.

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
