McKinney-Vento Grant in Indiana

On July 5, IDOE released the new Request for Proposals for the 2019-2022 McKinney-Vento award cycle.

The new RFP addresses new priorities and expectations for MV applicants, including an increased focus on coordination between local education agencies, and an opportunity to apply for either a 1-year or 3-year grant.



McKinney-Vento Grant in Indiana


Only 33 Indiana LEAs receive McKinney-Vento funding.

Just over 50% of Indiana's homeless students benefit from McKinney-Vento funding.



McKinney-Vento Grant in Indiana

How can we increase impact on homeless students?



McKinney-Vento Grant in Indiana

- **Expectation of coordination with other Indiana local education agencies and homeless-serving community organizations.**
- **Increased focus on high-impact grant activities.**
- **Designation of McKinney-Vento Consortium Coordinator for 3-year consortium applicants.**
- **New tools and resources for goal setting and outcome evaluation.**



McKinney Vento - Grant Requirements

- **Determine Option One (one year / independent LEA) or Option 2 (3 year/ consortium)**
- **Determine maximum eligibility based on total # students to be served**
- **Address Indiana DOE Priorities**
 - **Full compliance with McKinney Vento law**
 - **Increase awareness of homelessness & its impact on communities**
 - **Improve quality of data collection & reporting**
 - **Increase / Promote effective practices (collaborative, measurable)**
- **Authorized Activities**
 - **Funding priority to activities that directly address long term outcomes**



McKinney Vento - Grant Requirements

- **Collaboration**
 - **Social-emotional supports; Trauma-informed care; Financial well-being; Housing; Underserved populations**
 - **Requests for additional funding consideration - Option #2 applicants**
- **Monitoring**
 - **Desktop**
 - **On site monitoring (either part of a consolidated federal programs or stand alone)**
 - **Frequency will depend on implementation plan success and will vary by grantee**



McKinney Vento - Grant Proposal / Process

- **Priority given to applications following Option Two (consortium model)**
 - **Quality of project proposal; needs assessment; collaboration; ability to ID and meet outcomes**
 - **20 page limit; double spaced; 1 in margin / 12 pt font (Arial / Times New Roman)**
 - **Consortium applicants must designate a single coordinator**
 - Part A - Needs Assessment - 25 points
 - Part B - Project Description - 35 points
 - Part C - Consortium Planning & Development - 24 points (OPTION 2)
- Attachment A - Program Assurances - 5 points
- Attachment B - McKinney Vento Consortium Coordinator Job Description (OPTION 2)
- Attachment C - Consortium Consent Agreement (OPTION 2)



McKinney Vento - Grant Proposal / Process

OUTCOMES

- **Provide services that impact the achievement gap between homeless & non-homeless students**
- **Improve service provision through partnerships with local & regional youth serving organizations**
- **Develop and implement training to address enrollment, improve attendance, increase participation & improve academic success of homeless children**

July 2019

McKinney-Vento Request for Proposals Released

August 30th, 2019

**McKinney-Vento Grant Proposals Due
(1-year or 3-year option)**

September 2019

McKinney-Vento Grant Awards Announced

Summer 2020

**McKinney-Vento Request for Proposals Released and Submitted
(3-year option only)**
