Working Together for Student Success

The Title I, Part C, program for the education of migratory children is administered by the IDOE and Migrant Regional Centers who provide services to all migratory children enrolled in public or non-public schools within their geographical boundaries. All Migrant Regional Centers are required to consult annually with all non-public schools within their geographical region. Non-public schools accepting federal dollars and/or participating in the Choice program are expected to administer the Migrant Work Survey annually to all students in the school, and to notify their local Migrant Regional Center upon identification of a potentially eligible migrant student. Migrant Regional Centers coordinate all direct services for students enrolled in public and non-public schools within their region.
