

Instructions for Creating an IDOE Moodle Account

The Indiana Department of Education maintains an education and resource website for use by school personnel. This website is known as the IDOE Moodle. This learning platform can be accessed at the following link: <https://moodle.doe.in.gov/>.

Many school professionals (counselors, teachers, school safety specialists, etc.) have sections specifically designed for their specialty area. School nurses have their own section which includes several Online Courses and a School Nurse Community that is filled with folders of resources beneficial to school nurses. Some of these folders include information on the following topics: The Indiana School Nurse Manual, advocacy, delegation, chronic diseases, FERPA, laws, medications and mandatory reports as well as many others.

You must create a user account (one time) **in order to participate in any of the courses and/or to access the resource files.** To create an account, please go to the right side of the page and click on “create new account” to set up your username and password. **If you have previously created an account to take a course, there is no need to create a new account as you can log in using your current username and password.** If you have difficulty, additional instructions for creating an account can be found [here](#).

Please note that you will need an **enrollment key** in order to log into each of the courses or open the school nurse resource files. The list of enrollment keys are posted below.

Each of the online courses require the participant to take and pass a quiz. Once the participant passes the quiz, a certificate will become available for printing. At the end of each school year, these courses will be “cleared” and participants will be able to retake a course and print a new certificate.
