**Background:**

The Indiana General Assembly recently passed legislation pertaining to Cambridge International courses. Cambridge International course refers to a course from the Cambridge Assessment International Education program. IC 20-36-6 states that the Indiana State Board of Education and Indiana Department of Education will provide that a successfully completed Cambridge International course will be credited toward fulfilling requirements of an Indiana diploma with a Core 40 with academic honors designation.

**Guidance:**

Each student who enrolls in a Cambridge International course may take the accompanying Cambridge International examination to receive high school credit for the Cambridge International course.

A successfully completed Cambridge International course is credited toward fulfilling the requirements of an Indiana diploma with Core 40 Academic Honors designation.
