Re: Senate Enrolled Act SEA 108 – Education Matters (IC 20-26-11-32)

Background:

The Indiana General Assembly recently passed legislation that allows the governing body of a school corporation to discontinue enrollment currently or in subsequent school year, or establish terms and conditions for enrollment or continued enrollment in a subsequent year, if the student has had a history of unexcused absences and the governing body of the school corporation believes that, based upon the location of the student's residence, attendance would be a problem for the student if the student is enrolled with the school corporation.

This is a local decision made by the school corporation's governing body.
