

# Director of Curriculum & Instruction

To be a Director of Curriculum and Instruction, one meets the following requirements: (1) successfully completed the school leader's licensure assessment under 515 IAC 8-2-2; (2) Holds a practitioner license or accomplished practitioner license with at least 1 content area established under sections 8 through 39 of this rule. (3) Successfully completes an approved district administrator: director of curriculum and instruction education program. (4) Obtains a master's degree or, if already degreed, completed additional course work in a district administrator: director of curriculum and instruction.

The holder of the license with the content area district level administrator: director of curriculum and instruction is eligible to serve as an administrator in the school setting listed on the license.

## Required Documents:

- Valid CPR Card
- Transcripts showing master's degree or higher and date conferred
- Current Instructional License
