

# Superintendent License

To be a Superintendent, one meets the following requirements: (1) successfully complete the school leader's licensure assessment under 515 IAC 8-2-2; (2) successfully complete the following: (A) An education specialist (Ed.S) degree or higher at an institution of higher learning. (B) An approved district administrator: superintendent program and (3) Holds a Practitioner's license.

The holder of the license with the content area district level administrator: superintendent is eligible to serve as an administrator in any school in accordance with the school setting listed on the license.
