

SIS Vendors: This experience map includes the Student Information System (SIS) vendors serving Indiana schools. The purpose of this map is to articulate the desired vendor certification experience among those involved. The IDOE aims to design the experience for the best possible experience and outcome. The activities outlined in the chart below represent the ideal state of the certification process and how IDOE intends to support vendors each stage of certification.
