Re: Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Instruction Addendum / COVID-19

During the 2014 legislative session, the Governor signed P.L. 139-2014 (now codified at IC 20-30-5-20) into law. This law established requirements for CPR and AED instruction at the high school level. The 2014 guidance may be found [here](#). This memorandum serves as additional guidance during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Implications for students during COVID-19:

Students	Requirements
Seniors that have not received CPR and AED instruction.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students that were enrolled in or completed courses that offered CPR and AED instruction will be considered to have completed these requirements.2. School systems may waive the psychomotor skills component typically needed to graduate.
Students in grades 9 through 11 that have received CPR and AED instruction but need to complete the psychomotor skills component.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. School systems will need to delay the psychomotor skills component and ensure this instruction takes place at a later date.
