SUBJECT: April State Tuition Support Payment Update

The Office of School Finance has recalculated FY 2020 Basic Grant funding for school corporations and charter schools. The FY 2020 State Tuition Support Worksheet can be viewed and printed from the School Finance Application Center. Reviewing the worksheet will afford you the opportunity to review the individual data variables used in grant calculations. The site may be accessed at <https://stateaid.doe.in.gov/>. This is a secure site and will require a login and password. The login is the 4-digit corporation number and the password is the corporation PIN.

The April 15, 2020 Basic Grant reflects actual February 2020 average daily membership (ADM) non-virtual and virtual student counts. All grants in the FY 2020 School funding formula have now been reconciled using the final counts shown in the following table:

Form 54 information will not be available until April 15, 2020. To print the Form 54, you will need to set the print layout to landscape. The DOE 54 continues to reflect Veterans Memorial Fund and Common School Fund loan repayment amounts for January to June 2020. Lastly, some school districts will also have a Medicaid adjustment as part of the state's recovery for Medicaid. The recovery is for Medicaid reimbursements to school corporations that occurred in March 2020. The recovery amount is 34.16 percent. The Medicaid recovery appears on the DOE 54 in the Other Minus column.
