This memorandum provides clarification regarding funding of the 2021 AP exams based on IC 20-36-3-8 and House Enrolled Act 1001 (2019). The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) continues to support Indiana students through the AP exam subsidy. This subsidy covers exam fees for English, mathematics, science, and computer science AP exams taken by Indiana students in grades 9-12 who are enrolled in a corresponding AP course for Graduation Pathways or have received similarly approved instruction at an accredited public or nonpublic school.

Per Indiana Code, priorities for funding are given according to the following criteria and in the corresponding order until funds are fully expended:

- Students currently enrolled in grades 11 and 12
- Students currently enrolled in grades 9 and 10
- Students receiving free/reduced lunch participating in any AP exam outside of English, mathematics, science, and computer science
