RE: School Improvement Plans for SY 2019-20

Pursuant to IC 20-31-4-6(5) and 511 IAC 6.1-1-4(1)(J), all public schools, including charter schools, and state-accredited non-public schools must complete a school improvement plan with input from a committee of individuals interested in the school. 511 IAC 6.2-3-5(a) requires school improvement plans to be submitted to the Department of Education (Department) no later than June 30 of the school year before the year of implementation. However, this June 30th submission deadline was established prior to the administration of the statewide assessment during the spring.

Therefore, a school will be required to submit its school improvement plan for the 2019-20 school year to the Department **no later than October 11, 2019**. This will allow a school to review and consider a multitude of data points from the 2018-19 school year when revising its school improvement plan for the upcoming school year. Schools may begin submitting school improvement plans for the 2019-20 school year as of **June 7, 2019**.
