

Why the Data are Reported

The DOE-SE report the mechanism used to gather counts for state tuition–special education funding in compliance with IC 20-43-7. Report data for students that have an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Service Plan (SP) for a non-public school student on count dates **December 2, 2019 and April 1, 2020**.

What the Data Impact

- The data will be used for state tuition-special education funding as required by **IC 20-43-7**.
- Identification of student accountability for Annual Performance Report (APR).
- Information is used for federal and state reporting and monitoring under Article 7 (**511 IAC 7-46**).

Audience

- This is a required collection for:
- Public schools (Traditional and Charter)

IMPORTANT!!!

- **SE Funding will be received by the corporation that is legally responsible for the student's Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) under 511 IAC 7-33-2(a) or a Service Plan under 511 IAC 7-34-1.**
✓ **Special education funding will be determined by the special education December 2 count only.**
- **Count days for the 2019-2020 school year will be December 2, 2019 and April 1, 2020.**
- Corporation that is legally responsible for the student's Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) or Service Plan reports the data (including students enrolled in another Public school, Non-Public, Homeschool, Indiana School for the Deaf and Indiana School for the Blind).
- A RT (Real Time) record is required or SE record will fail.
- If the public school is responsible for Special Education services for a student not enrolled in a public school, an RA (Real Time Access) record is required or SE record will fail.
- If the public corporation is servicing a student located in a Public Preschool Program or a Community Based Private Preschool the Preschool's state school ID is to be reported on this collection.

Instructions

- During each of the collection periods it is required to submit a file, review the processing results of the file for errors, and review the reports under Data Verification > Reports > Special Education for accuracy.
- These reports are provided as a verification resource and should be printed and reviewed by the responsible person(s).
- If there are any errors or inaccuracies, correct the data file and resubmit until the end of the day of the final cleanup phase.
- The STN number must exist in the STN Lookup.
- An input screen is available in the Application Center under Data Transfer>Input Forms>Special Education. This screen will also allow submitted student data to be edited and/or deleted.

Counting Students

Report data for the student with a disability who is receiving services for which the reporting corporation is responsible to maintain student's IEP (including students enrolled in another Public corporation, Non-public schools, Homeschool, Indiana School for the Deaf and Indiana School for the Blind).

1. PK students who reach age 6 between December 2 and April 1 - Use Special Education (SE) placement type codes 26-38 (field #7). KG students who reach age 6 between December 2 and April 1 - Use any Special education (SE) placement type code.
2. **Grade exceptions** can be requested for special education students attending a school that does not include the student's current grade level. Please contact the Office of Data Reporting at (317) 232-0808 or you may submit the request via <https://help.doe.in.gov> to request a grade level exception.

Conflict Resolution

- Conflicts occur when two or more corporations report the same student as part of their special education count. All conflicts need to be resolved quickly and accurately.
- Conflict may be created when the educating corporation and the corporation that is responsible for the IEP submit an SE record. **The corporation responsible for the IEP reports SE data.** A conflict may also occur when a student withdraws from one corporation and enrolls in another corporation on count date.
- The DOE-SE records in conflict are **removed** from the database until the schools/corporations work together to determine which corporation may not count the student then delete that SE record.
- Contact information on submitting schools is available in the conflict resolution area.
- Conflicts can be deleted and/or resolved on the **Conflict Resolution Page** or the **Input Form Area** (found under Data Transfer>Input Forms)

Upload Summary Report Feature –The signed Special Education Summary Report must be uploaded back into the Application Center.

- Sign off in Collection Management (under data verification).
- Print The Summary Report located under Data Verification>Reports>Special Education>SE Summary Report.
- Scan the signed document.
- Upload the signed document under Administration>Upload Signed Summary Report. **Verify that the correct period is selected before uploading.**
- To verify the document has been uploaded correctly go back to Collection Management to find in the sign off box the word **SUBMITTED**.

Students Not Reported

1. PW students (preschool ages 0-2) are **NOT** reported on the SE collection
2. Students no longer requiring special education services as of count day, as determined by the case conference committee, will **NOT** be counted on the SE report.
 - If students transition out of the special education program and no longer have an IEP or ISP, be sure to report them on the Termination data collection (DOE-TR).

School and Location Reporting

1. Report school # “9999” in **Field #1** when a school does not have a state assigned school number; the Location must then be identified in (field #8).
2. Students attending a non-public school or private setting and are receiving special education services from the public school are included on the public school’s SE report.
 - Enter the correct non-public school or private setting number where the student(s) attends in **Field 1**.
 - Use “9999” **if** the non-public school or private setting does not have a state assigned school number.
 - Check with your Special Education director for details about which location code should be used in **Field #8**.
 - If the public corporation is servicing a student located in a Public Preschool Program or a Community Based Private Preschool the Preschool’s state school ID is to be reported on this collection.
3. Students attending an accredited private school and are receiving services from the public school are included on the public school’s SE report.
 - Enter the private school’s state-assigned school number in Field #1 and the Location code (**Field #8**) will be “99”. Code “99” should be used in Field 8 (Location) because the school has a state-assigned school number.
4. Students attending an Alternative school that includes both general education and special education students is not considered a “separate day school facility”.
 - Enter the correct code in **Field #7** (Special Education Placement Type) according to the student’s placement in the alternative school.

DOE-SE Funding

- **Special Education funding will be based upon the corporation that reported period 1 DOE-SE.**
- **Data Review:** The APC funding report will be available for review in the Application Center. The DOE-SE count generates State APC funding; however, this count does not generate the Federal Part B and 619 Preschool funding for the federal grant applications.
