


INDIANA PRIMARY 2020: HOW TO REQUEST TO VOTE BY MAIL

To vote in the 2020 Indiana Primary, you must have been registered to vote by May 4. The voter registration deadline for the General Election is October 5, 2020.



1. Visit indianavoters.in.gov

2. Under Vote by Mail or Traveling Abroad, Click **Apply Online/Get Forms**

3. On the following page, click

VISIT MY VOTER PORTAL

4. On the following screen, enter your **First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth, and County of Registration** and click **submit**.

5. Verify your information is correct and click **continue**.

* It is recommended you add **two-step verification** for security.

6. On the menu on the left side of your Voter Portal, click **Absentee Voting**, then **Vote By Mail**.

7. On the application, verify your **current registration address**.

3. **PRIMARY ELECTION ONLY***

Under state law, you must request a major political party ballot to vote in a primary election. You may vote on a public question without voting a political party ballot, if a referendum (public question) is held on the same day as the primary. I apply for the ballot of political party, a majority of whose candidate I voted for at the last general election, or whom I intend to vote for in the next general election:

8. Check **Same as Registration Address** if your mailing address is the same.

9. Using the dropdown menu, **select your party**.

10. Authorize your signature and click **Submit**.
