

The Office of Student Assessment has provided several Moodle training courses for current Indiana educators which:

- Explain the process for scoring open-ended responses,
- Give examples of student responses from a range of score points,
- Provide scoring notes that clarify what is expected of students, and
- Provide opportunities for participants to apply rubrics by scoring practice responses.

These courses are secure; only current Indiana Educators will be allowed to enroll. Educators should contact Corporation Test Coordinators for enrollment instructions. - Scoring Math Grades 6-8 and 10 Open-Ended Items (previously available)

Each course requires approximately 60 minutes to complete. Participants may leave their work and return to it at any time. After completing the course, a certificate confirming completion for Professional Growth Points will be available to print.
