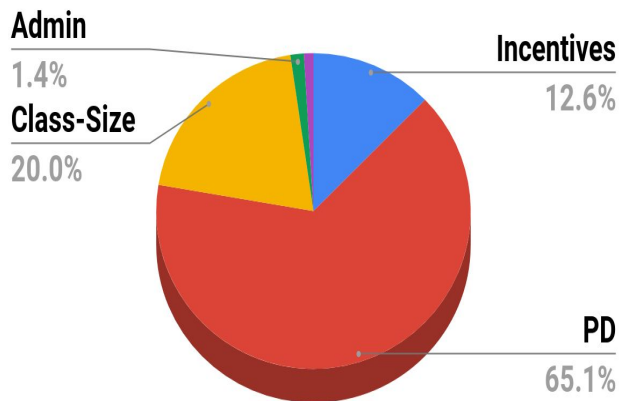

ESSA Updates: Highly Qualified Status for Title I Served Schools

Highly Qualified Teacher Verification forms are no longer required under ESSA. Schools must follow state statute and regulations for teacher qualifications.

Instructional paraprofessionals must be Highly Qualified (HQ) at the time of hire.

Required HQ Paraprofessional Documentation:

- ★ Secondary school diploma and college transcripts (2 years of study); or
- ★ Parapro Exam with passing score of 460 or higher; or
- ★ Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential
