Indiana's Educating the Whole Child Summit

In collaboration with the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) and the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addictions (DMHA), the Indiana School Mental Health Initiative (ISMHI) at Indiana University is honored to host Indiana's first Educating the Whole Child Summit. The Summit will be held from 11:30 am on Wednesday, February 27th, 2019 through 5:30 pm on Thursday, February 28th, 2019 at the Monroe County Convention Center in Bloomington, Indiana. Registration opens and box lunches available beginning at 10:30am.

Outcomes:

- Leave with an understanding of the importance of effectively implementing a full continuum of integrated school mental health approaches to support students' academics, behaviors, and social-emotional outcomes...THE WHOLE CHILD.
- Collective Learning: Diverse district teams will come together to hear new information and identify next actionable steps at the same time they develop a vision for larger system change.
- Opportunities for school district personnel and their community partners to connect with one another and expert resources/technical assistance.
- Learn about state collaborative efforts to address the whole child.

As the Indiana Department of Education strives to support districts in addressing the Whole Child, they are providing the funds for two people (one administrator and one school-based personnel) from each Title IV district to attend. Up to 200 people will get free registration. Registration code for these two free registrations is DOE18.

Each team will look different, but the following are suggested members of a district team:

- Person most responsible within district for overseeing SEL/Mental Health
- An administrator
- Teacher
- Key school-based community mental health provider
- Student Services Personnel
