

School Meal Service Operation and Student Schedule

Only eLearning

- 1) Serve meals on-site.
- 2) Provide meals to take home. Only one meal (i.e. one meal for breakfast and one meal for lunch) per child per day is allowed even if multiple meals are provided.

Both options can operate the National School Lunch Program (NSLP)/School Breakfast Program (SBP):

- Must follow ALL meal pattern requirements
*includes all vegetable subgroups for lunch
- Meal count by paid, free, and reduced unless CEP or Provision 2/3
- Non-congregate allowed



Rotation of Students

Students on-site one week/specific days and other students at home

- Operate under NSLP/SBP
- Must follow ALL meal pattern requirements
*includes all vegetable subgroups
- Meal count by paid, free, and reduced unless CEP or Provision 2/3
- Non-congregate allowed

All Students On-Site

- Operate under NSLP/SBP
- Must follow ALL meal pattern requirements
*includes all vegetable subgroups for lunch
- Meal count by paid, free, and reduced unless CEP or Provision 2/3
- Non-congregate allowed



Students Attending Half-Day

- 1) Serve meals on-site.
- 2) Provide meals to take home. Only one meal (i.e. one meal for breakfast and one meal for lunch) per child per day is allowed even if multiple meals are provided.

Both options can operate NSLP/SBP:

- Must follow ALL meal pattern requirements
*includes all vegetable subgroups for lunch
- Meal count by paid, free, and reduced unless CEP or Provision 2/3
- Non-congregate allowed

*Food production records, free potable water (when on-site), special dietary needs, meal counts at POS, etc. are still required.
