

Florida citrus fruits are good for your body. They help you grow. The citrus fruits on this page have vitamin C. You need vitamin C to help fight colds.






Below are sections of a Florida tangerine. There are sections to write nouns, verbs and adjectives. Write an example of each part of speech in the tangerine sections.



Just like fresh citrus fruits have different parts, so do sentences. Most sentences have a subject (*noun*) and an action (*verb*). *Adjectives* are words that are used to describe nouns. Nouns, verbs and adjectives are all called *parts of speech*.

A **noun** is a person, place or thing.

Florida, farmer and tree are all nouns.




A **verb** is a word that shows action or being.

Grow, peel and eat are all verbs.



An **adjective** is a word that describes a noun.

Sweet, round and delicious are all adjectives.
