His professional career has included graphic design, software development, and workflow analysis. The death of his daughter, Emily, at the hands of a gunman at Platte Canyon High School compelled Mr. Keyes to bring his professional expertise to the arena of school safety. The Keyes family's response to the events at Platte Canyon High School was immediate support for first responders and compassionate outreach to law enforcement. The Keyes' hope these direct and positive actions can act as a guidepost for families impacted by violence.

Topics to Be Covered Include:

Standard Response Protocols-Common language common response program that can be utilized in any school or community emergency situation. This program provides four specific actions which are easy to train to students, staff, and all other school stakeholders and first responders.

Reunification Protocols-Proven methods for planning, practicing and achieving a successful reunification after an unforeseen emergency at school. This program provides insight to educators and law enforcement to maintain the custody of every student until they are reunited with their custodial parent.
