Over the course of three years, most of the waivers given (91%) were Evidence-Based waivers. Of the total 165 waivers given over the three years, 35 were given for English only (21%), 57 were given for Math only (35%), and 73 were given for both subjects (44%). If the data were considered for each cohort individually, the numbers are approximately the same. Additionally, 45% of the waivers were given to females and 55% were given to males. 78% of the waivers were given to students who receive free or reduced lunch. 32% of the waivers were given to ELL students and 57% were SPED. Of students receiving waivers over the last three years, 27% were White, 49% were African-American, and 22% were Hispanic. Approximately 62% of the waivers were given to students in our alternative education program.
