Several of our teachers received 3 years of this training under the TAG, while other teachers (those brought in this year) will only receive 1 year of training. The Veteran Teachers that have the proper grasp on the training will be used to mentor the new teachers and bring them into alignment with the core teachings of the programs provided by the TAG.
