The school needs to add \$50,000 to fulfill all staff salaries.</i>	<i>In order for all students to attend the before and after school program for the 200 student days, the school will need to move funds from technology and supplies over to instruction to fulfill all staff salaries.</i>
Community Service Operations	\$37,592 was budgeted for behaviorist salary	The Behaviorist position works with students and teachers daily on their behaviors and choices made at school during the day. She works with students individually and in small groups. Since she works with students and not parents or community members this funing should be in the support services-students line.	\$37,592 has been moved from Community Service Operations line to the Support Services-students line to better reflect what this money is spent on. That will change that salary line to \$70,006.
Community Service Operations	\$14,433 was budgeted for behaviorist benefits	Due to moving the behaviorist salary to the support services- students the benefits also need to be moved to this line.	\$14,433 moved from community service operations benefits to support services benefits line. That will change the total of that line to \$21,643.
