The chairman called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. with the following visitor in attendance, Phyllis Usher, Deputy Superintendent, Department of Education.

The chairman inquired if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes from the October 23, 2007 meeting. With none being made, Ms. Huntington made a motion to accept the minutes. Seconded by Ms. Koerner. Motion carried unanimously.
